General English (CRICOS CODE: 115576D)



1 Starter (CEFR Level A1)

Learners can engage in basic conversations using polite expressions, understand simple dialogues, recognize everyday vocabulary, describe routines and opinions with correct grammar, use simple tenses and articles, and discuss topics like family, weather, and food.

2 Elementary (CEFR Level A2)

Students can discuss familiar topics with some fluency, understand main ideas and speaker attitudes, comprehend basic texts, express ideas clearly with proper reasoning and punctuation, and use a limited range of grammar and vocabulary with basic word-building skills.



3 Pre-Intermediate (CEFR Level B1)

Develop fluency in discussions by supporting ideas with examples, understand key details and inferences in listening, comprehend various texts through skimming and scanning, write structured paragraphs with cohesive reasoning, use diverse grammatical structures, and expand vocabulary with word-building strategies.



4 Intermediate (CEFR Level B1+)

Demonstrate effective communication by discussing various topics coherently with examples, understanding key ideas and details through confident listening strategies, reading and analyzing texts of varying complexity, writing structured texts with logical flow, using accurate grammar, and expanding vocabulary across familiar and new topics.



5 Upper Intermediate (CEFR Level B2)

Demonstrate fluent and flexible communication across various topics, with strong comprehension, reading, writing, grammatical accuracy, and a broad vocabulary.

Placement Test: Students come to Future English with different proficiencies across four macro skills and, as a result, all students need to take a placement test before the commencement of classes

IELTS TEST PREPARATION (CRICOS CODE: 115577C)

The IELTS Preparation course is designed to equip students with the necessary skills and strategies to excel in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) examination. This comprehensive course integrates the four macro skills essential for success: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Through a combination of theoretical instruction, practical exercises, and simulated exam experiences, students will develop their language proficiency and test-taking abilities, enabling them to achieve their desired scores on the IELTS exam.

Future English offers two levels of the IELTS Preparation course to cater to students with 2 different proficiency levels:



1 IELTS Foundation

Tailored for students targeting an IELTS score **6.0 to 6.5** through the course duration of **10 weeks**. With focused instruction and targeted practice, students delve into the intricacies of the English language, honing their skills to meet the exam's demands.

2 IELTS Advanced

Catering to students targeting an IELTS score of 7.0 or higher through the course duration of 10 weeks. The course is designed to push the boundaries of language proficiency. Through advanced strategies and challenging exercises, students delve deeper into the language specifics, refining their abilities to achieve excellence in the IELTS examination.

IELTS Foundation

Students who want to start the Foundation IELTS course must meet one of the following conditions:

- Complete Upper-intermediate level in General English
- Bringing an IELTS certificate with an overall band score of 5.5 or equivalent.
- Scoring an average of 60% on the English placement test

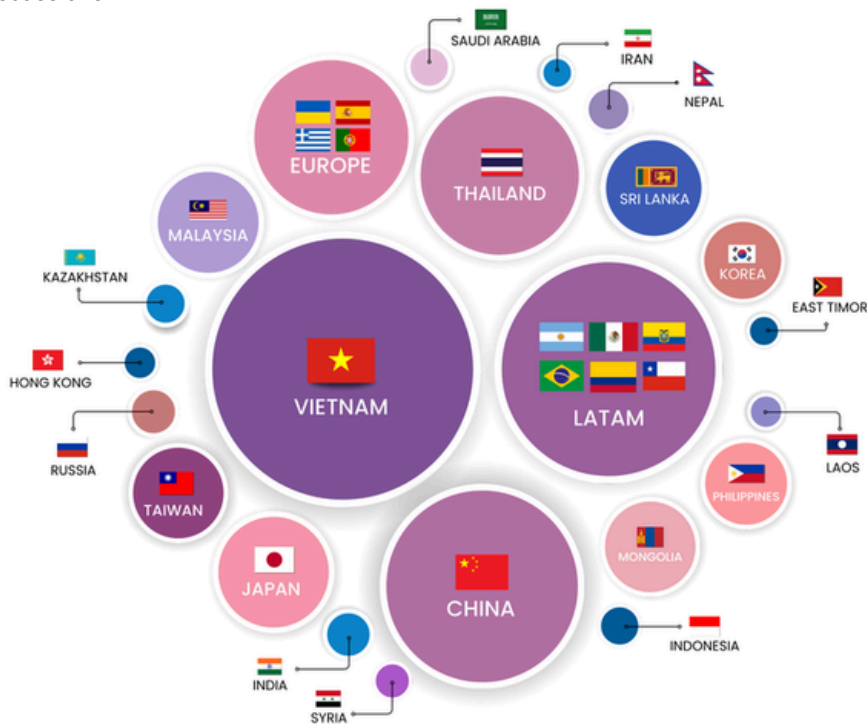
IELTS Advanced

Students who want to start the Advanced IELTS course must meet one of the following conditions:

- Bringing an IELTS certificate with an overall band score of 6.5 or equivalent.
- Scoring an average of 70% on the English placement test

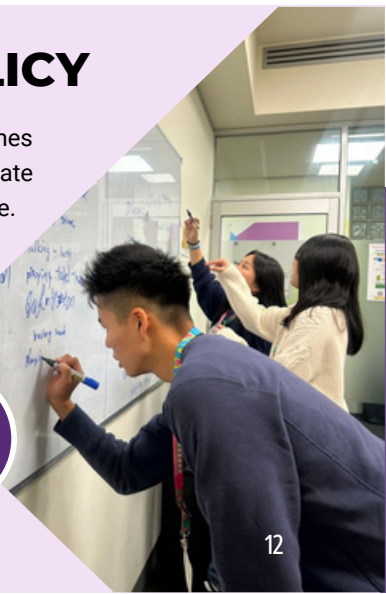


SPEAK ENGLISH ONLY POLICY

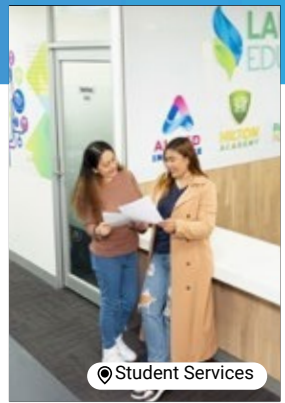

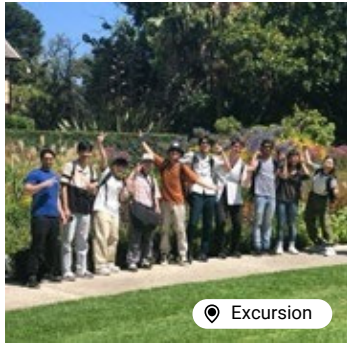
